**Fees:** Spaces 12' wide by 10' deep are \$4.00 per market day. Table spaces 5' wide by 6' deep are \$2.00 per market day.

Market hours are from 7:30 am to 1:00 pm each Wednesday and Saturday starting in early May and running through October 30, 2019. Consult "Wednesday & Saturday Market Set-up Procedures" on our website for more information. All spaces are assigned by the Farmers' Market Manager or his designee.

**To sell at the market during special events, i.e. craft fairs, you must have attended a minimum of *three* previous market days to qualify. Please read 'Farmers' Market Rules & Regulations' on our website for details about product eligibility requirements. The 'Statement of Production' must be signed and included with your application.**

**Smoking by vendors at the market is only permitted in the designated 'smoking area'.**

**This application must reach the Farmers' Market Manager at least *seven* days before you plan to attend your first market. Mail it to: Baraboo Farmers' Market, P.O. Box 178, Baraboo, WI 53913.**

**The market generally starts about one week before Mother's Day.**

A legal-for-trade, certifiable scale is required to sell the following items at the Baraboo Farmers' Market:

Asparagus, beans (fresh & dried), beets without tops, broccoli, cabbage, carrots without tops, grains, potatoes (all), radishes without tops, rutabagas, nuts, seeds, and all value-added bulk products, i.e. barley flour, wheat flour.

Sales Tax must be charged on inedible products. Wisconsin Dept. of Revenue sellers permit required.

\* Processing means canning, extracting, fermenting, distilling, pickling, freezing, baking, drying, smoking, grinding, cutting, mixing, coating, stuffing, packaging, bottling, roasting, or any other process to treat, conserve or package food.
