
# 2023 Processed Agricultural Products List

The following raw or processed products require labeling, licensing and/or permits:

Asparagus, beans (fresh & dried), beets without tops, broccoli, cabbage, carrots without tops, grains, potatoes Apple Cider (all), radishes without tops, rutabagas, nuts, seeds, and all value-added bulk products, i.e. barley flour, wheat flour. Bakery Items (Licensed Commercial Kitchen required for vending) Bakery Items (fruit-based) (Licensed Commercial Kitchen required for vending) Canned Food, Low Acid (cannot be sold at Farmers' Markets) Dry Food (flour, mixes, blends, etc.) Fruit (cut) Fruit (frozen) If you are exempt from certain licenses, Grain and Seed the Farmers' Market Manager requires a written statement to that effect. Herbal and Flavored Vinegars Honey (raw) Jams and Jellies Maple Syrup Sales Tax must be charged on inedible Vegetables (cut) products. Wisconsin Dept. of Revenue Vegetables (frozen) sellers permit required. Vegetables (pickled) Animals/Captive Game/Exotics (pheasant, deer, bison) Aquaculture (farmed fish and seafood) Processing means canning, extracting, fermenting, Dairy (butter, cream, fluid milk) distilling, pickling, freezing, baking, drying, Dairy (cheese from pasteurized milk) smoking, grinding, cutting, mixing, coating, Dairy (cheese from raw milk) stuffing, packaging, bottling, roasting, or any other Dairy (flavored milk, ice cream, kefir, sour cream, yogurt) process to treat, conserve or package food. Eggs Livestock (beef, pork, sheep, goats, ratites) Poultry (farm-raised chicken, ducks, geese, guinea hens, squab, turkeys) Rabbits Nursery Stock Plants (bedding, potted, hanging baskets) Cut Flowers Personal Care Products (Soap, hand lotions, etc.) Herbal Products (tinctures, teas) Maple Sugar Candy Pet Food and Treats
