To sell at the market during special events, i.e. craft fairs, you must have attended a minimum of *three* previous market days to qualify, unless approved by the Market Manager. Please read 'Farmers' Market Rules & Regulations' on our website for details about product eligibility requirements. The 'Statement of Production' must be signed and included with your application. Smoking by vendors is prohibited.

This application must reach the Farmers' Market Manager at least *seven* days before you plan to attend your first market. Mail it to: Baraboo Farmers' Market, E7429 Copper Spring Ln. Reedsburg, WI 53959.

The market generally starts about one week before Mother's Day.

A legal-for-trade, certifiable scale is required to sell the following items at the Baraboo Farmers' Market:

Asparagus, beans (fresh & dried), beets without tops, broccoli, cabbage, carrots without tops, grains, potatoes (all), radishes without tops, rutabagas, nuts, seeds, and all value-added bulk products, i.e. barley flour, wheat flour.

Sales Tax must be charged on inedible products. Wisconsin Dept. of Revenue sellers permit required.

Processing means canning, extracting, fermenting, distilling, pickling, freezing, baking, drying, smoking, grinding, cutting, mixing, coating, stuffing, packaging, bottling, roasting, or any other process to treat, conserve or package food.
