Asparagus, beans (fresh & dried), beets without tops, broccoli, cabbage, carrots without tops, grains, potatoes (all), radishes without tops, rutabagas, nuts, seeds, and all value-added bulk products, i.e. barley flour, wheat flour.

If you are exempt from certain licenses, the Farmers' Market Manager requires a written statement to that effect.

Sales Tax must be charged on inedible products. Wisconsin Dept. of Revenue sellers permit required.

Processing means canning, extracting, fermenting, distilling, pickling, freezing, baking, drying, smoking, grinding, cutting, mixing, coating, stuffing, packaging, bottling, roasting, or any other process to treat, conserve or package food.
